I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Penn called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. Present were Mayor Mary Penn, Mayor Pro Tem Shaun Myers and Council Members Mike Thomas, Robbie Powers and Kevin Moon. Council Member David Johnson was absent. Also present was City Attorney Jon Thatcher.

Mayor Penn called for a motion to go into Executive Session. Council Member Thomas made a motion to go into Executive Session at 4:01 p.m. and Mayor Pro Tem Myers seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 5 ayes, 1 vacancy and 1 absent [Johnson].
